





## Prioritisation of prescriptions received by reCare from reScript (DrInfo)

reCare has preset prioritisations for the following prescriptions to float to the top of the queue:

- prescriptions for patients aged over 80 years
- if the product needs compounding
- if the word **Urgent** appears in the doctor's **Note to pharmacy**

Prescribers using reScript (DrInfo) to send prescriptions to pharmacy can use either option 1 or option 2 described in the table below,

	<b>Option 1:</b> GP sends prescription direct to patient's chosen pharmacy	<b>Option 2:</b> GP sends prescription to patient mobile phone for patient to select pharmacy of choice	
<p>GP uses reScript (DrInfo) to send prescription generated in PMS. This is faster and more secure than routing the prescription to the pharmacy email address.</p> 	<p>GP has the patient mobile number recorded. Patient receives notification on mobile phone with options to inform the pharmacy when the prescription is required.</p> <p>If patient doesn't have a mobile phone, GP needs to add the word <b>Urgent</b> in the <b>Note to pharmacy</b> if patient is going straight from GP to pharmacy to collect prescription.</p> 	<p><b>Step 1:</b> Patient receives notification on mobile phone and a link to select the pharmacy of their choice for the prescription to be pushed to,</p>  <p><b>Step 2:</b> Patient needs to open the link to select the pharmacy of choice,</p> 	<p><b>Step 3:</b> Patient receives notification on mobile phone with options to inform the pharmacy when the prescription is required,</p>
